### **Promoting Participation**

<u>Gifted & Talented Year 5 & 6</u> The school identified talented students from both year 5 & year 6 to take part in our Gifted and Talented camps. Students had the opportunity to participate in a wide range of sports that they may not have had the opportunity to take part in before. The year 6 students also took part in various sports science workshops revolving around topics such as exercise physiology and nutrition.

#### **Change 4 Life**

Edmondsley have given their less engaged students the opportunity to take part in a 12 week Change 4 Life Afterschool Club where the focus is on the children being active and having fun rather than competitive sport.



#### **Durham DASH**

Students from the School took part in this year's Durham Dash, The Dash! provides an inspirational athletics event for primary school children within a unique County Durham setting, and at the same time promotes sport and physical activity as a positive lifestyle choice for children and their families.

#### **Cluster Group Project**

Edmondsley were involved in a Cluster Pilot project in the 2018/19 aimed at giving schools the opportunity to run their own festivals/events with guidance. As a result of the being involved in the project the children from Edmondsley were able to attend a Year 6 Rounders Competition and a Year 3 Athletics event.
