ENGLISH

Non-fiction recount/dilemma stories.

In English this half term we will begin by writing a recount of an explorer's visit to the rainforest. We will then read the book 'The Great Kapok Tree' as we explore stories with a dilemma.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Begin to use paragraphs to group related sentences.
- Use different planning methods before writing.
- Start to understand the audience and purpose of different types of writing.
- Discuss and record ideas through writing and diagrams.
- Use a range of connectives and conjunctions.
- Use a range of punctuation including commas in a list, exclamation marks and question marks.

COMPUTING

During this half term, we will be looking at algorithms.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Know that computers need precise instructions.
- Show care and precision to avoid errors
- Know that computers have no intelligence and that computers can do nothing unless a program is run.

RF

This half term we will be learning about Signs and Symbols.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Recognise meanings contained in stories, objects and signs.
- Understand how symbols help believers to express the concept of God

MATHS

Place Value / Addition and Subtraction

Our Objectives will be to:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three -digit number
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally, including: a three-digit number and ones, tens and hundreds.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.
- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

SCIENCE

Plants

Our Objectives will be to:

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
- Compare the effect of different factors on plant growth.
