ENGLISH

Traditional Tales/Recounts.

In English this half term we will read the story 'Babushka' as we explore traditional tales. We think then look at recounts and write newspaper reports about Russian historical events.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Begin to use paragraphs to group related sentences.
- Use different planning methods before writing.
- Start to understand the audience and purpose of different types of writing.
- Discuss and record ideas through writing and diagrams.
- Uses headings and sub-headings to organise and structure non-fiction writing
- Identifies and uses a range of prepositions
- Use a range of punctuation including commas in a list, exclamation marks and question marks.

COMPUTING

During this half term, we will be looking at algorithms.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Know that all software executed on digital devices is programmed
- know that users can write their own programs.
- create a simple program.
- run, check and change programs.
- know that computers need exact instructions
- know that a range of digital devices can be considered a computer.
- use a range of input and outputs

MATHS

Addition and Subtraction/Multiplication and Division

Our Objectives will be to:

Addition and Subtraction

- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

Multiplication and Division

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
- Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables they know, including for two -digit numbers times one -digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division, including positive integer scaling problems and correspondence problems in which n objects are connected to m objectives.

SCIENCE

Animals including humans.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition.
- Identify that animals cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons for support and protection.
- Identify that humans and animals have muscles that allow them to move.
- Investigate how different parts of the body have special functions.
