ENGLISH

In English during this half term, we will be focussing predominantly on developing our reading skills and our understand of terminology in SPAG

- Fiction texts
- Non-fiction texts
- Poetry
- Punctuation and Grammar exercises

MATHS

In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus primarily on statistics, ratio and algebra as well as covering all aspects of Maths, ready for our SATs

- Interpreting bar charts, line graph and pie charts
- Working out the mean
- Revising scatter graphs and pictograms
- Working out percentages and solving ratio problems
- Solving formula, missing number and linear series problems
- Reading writing Roman numerals

We will also continue to revise all key areas of arithmetic from the Autumn term: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, percentage, BIDMAS and multiplying/dividing by 10

SCIENCE

In Science during this half term our focus will be on Light, we will be:

- 1. Recognising that light appears to travel in straight lines
- Using the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- Explaining that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- 4. Using the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
- 5. Investigating coloured filters



GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

In History and Geography this term our focus will be on the Viking civilisation. Within this we will be:

- 1. Locating the countries of Europe where the Vikings lived and expanded to
- 2. Drawing sketch maps using symbols & a key,
- 3. Describing and understanding key aspects of physical geography, including: mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle features
- 4. Learning about the Vikings using Primary and Secondary sources.
